1. Registration for “Thesis (intensive courses)” is now available.

- If you plan to write a thesis and wish to obtain credits, please submit the application form according to the schedule below. (Application form is distributed at the GBP/SCOPE Office)
- Those who have applied for Early Graduation **MUST** register for “Thesis”.

	[For Spring Semester (intensive)]: 4th year Students and Applicants for Early Graduation in 3 years	[For Fall Semester (intensive)]: ONLY for applicants for Early Graduation in 3.5 years
(1) Application Form distribution	Late September (5 th or 7 th semester)	Early April (6 th semester)
(2) Submit the form after obtaining permission from a SCOPE faculty member who will give advises on your “Thesis”	From Early October <u>to the Last day of the class registration period for the Spring semester</u>	From Early April <u>to the Last day of the class registration period for the Fall semester</u>
(3) Registration	Late April (6 th or 8 th semester)	Late September (7 th semester)
